When on an expedition, participants should be as unaccompanied as possible. Therefore, we recommend all participants undertake a day walk as part of their training. It is vital to have the practical skills and experience needed to complete an unaccompanied expedition. This kit list is our recommended kit for your supervised day walk training. All items must be brought with you, other items are optional. You can bring kit that is not on this list but please ensure they are not on 'the bad list'.

The 'Bad' List

This list is not exhaustive. If you are not sure about an item, please ask Ms Stone.

Below is a list of items which we will not allow participants to bring on an expedition:

- Jeans
- Any non-rucksack style bags (ie, handbags, carry-alls, suitcases, etc)
- Umbrellas
- Any electronic devices (other than a camera)
- Glass, mirrors or sharp items that cannot be sheathed
