We ask students to:

- aim high in everything you do
- attend College regularly (aim for 100%) and on time
- work hard in class and complete homework on time
- be equipped to work and use your student planner
- behave with courtesy and consideration to others
- respect staff, one another and other people's belongings
- know and follow the College Behaviour and Dress Codes
- be honest when things go wrong and accept responsibility for your actions
- ask a member of staff for help if you are having difficulty with your work
- remember that the good reputation of the College within the local area rests with you.

We ask parents to:

- make sure their daughter attends regularly, on time and in full College dress
- avoid taking holidays during term time. All absence from school has a negative effect on a student's learning
- send their daughter to College with all the necessary equipment and/or kit
- provide support for their daughter to work at home and encourage her to take responsibility for her own learning
- support their daughter by attending Parents' Evenings and school events
- reinforce College rules and support the College Behaviour Code, which includes ensuring that adequate travel arrangements are made if an after school detention is set
- contact us if they have a worry or a concern about their daughter
- work in partnership with staff to help their daughter to achieve at her highest level
- sign their daughter's student planner each week to confirm homework is being completed work with college staff to sort out any concerns
- update the College immediately should their contact details change.

We ask staff to:

- make sure all students feel safe, happy and free from discrimination at school
- value, respect and be fair to each individual and praise their achievements and effort
- have high but realistic expectations of students
- listen to students' ideas, opinions, concerns and respond as needed
- deal with any difficulties in a positive and supportive way
- set homework to help students learn after school
- apply behaviour and dress codes consistently
- mark work regularly and give feedback to students
- keep parents informed about their daughter's progress
- respond to parental questions promptly.
